

COMPETITION RULES

10 years of Badgy competition

Article 1: Organization

EVOLIS SAS ("the Organizer"), a simplified joint stock company with capital of 417,948.96 euros, headquartered at ZI ANGERS BEAUCOUZE 14 AVENUE DE LA FONTAINE 49070 BEAUCOUZE, is organizing a free game with no obligation to buy from October 30, 2024 to November 20, 2024 at 11:59 pm.

Article 2: Participants

This free, no-obligation game is open exclusively to adults who have:

- Internet access,
- A valid e-mail address,

Persons who do not meet the above conditions are excluded from the game, as are members of the Organizer's staff and any person directly or indirectly involved in the design, production or management of the game, as well as their spouses and family members.

The Organizer reserves the right to ask any participant to provide proof of the above conditions. Any person failing to meet these conditions or refusing to provide proof will be excluded from the game and, in the event of winning, will not be entitled to his or her prize.

Only one entry per person (same name, same address) is permitted. The Organizer reserves the right to verify compliance with this rule.

Participation in the game implies express and unreserved acceptance of these rules.

Article 3: Terms of participation

To take part in the game, participants must go to the "blog" section of the Badgy.com website, and fill in the form at the end of the article entitled: "Badgy100 and 200 have been making an impression for 10 years now!"

A draw will then be made under the conditions of the present rules. The game will be online from October 30, 2024 to November 20, 2024. Any participation outside this period will not be counted.

The participant must completely and correctly fill in the information form in order for his/her registration to be validated. Filling in the information form will give him/her a chance to be drawn. The player is informed and accepts that the information entered in the registration form is proof of identity.

Any participation made contrary to the provisions of the present rules will render the participation invalid. Any participant suspected of fraud may be dismissed from the contest by the Organizer without justification. Any identification or participation that is incomplete, erroneous or illegible, whether intentionally or not, or made in a form other than that provided for in the present rules will be considered null and void. The same penalty will apply in the event of multiple entries.

Article 4: Winnings

The following prizes will be awarded to valid participants who are declared winners:

- Prize: a complete Badgy200 solution including: a Badgy200 card printer, a consumables kit (color ribbon for 100 prints and PVC cards), Badge Studio card creation and personalization software, access to the card library, all with a unit value of €699 per kit (manufacturer's recommended price).

The value of the prizes is determined at the time of drafting these rules and cannot be contested.

The final terms and conditions for awarding the prize will be indicated to the winner by the Organizer in the e-mail announcing the prize.

In the event of an event beyond its control or due to unforeseeable circumstances, the Organizer reserves the right to substitute, at any time, for the proposed prize, a prize of equivalent value or similar characteristics.

In all cases, the Organizer cannot be held responsible for any damage or delay that may occur in the delivery of the prize.

Article 5: Delivery of prizes

Game winners will be notified by e-mail. On this occasion, they will be asked to provide the following information: "last name - first name - postal address" in order to be able to send them their prize.

If the winner does not come forward within 15 days of being notified of his/her prize by e-mail, he/she will be deemed to have forfeited his/her prize. Unallocated prizes will not be reallocated.

No message will be sent to the losers.

The prizes will be sent within 7 weeks of receipt of the winner's postal address.

Article 6: Use of participants' personal data

The participant's personal data is collected and processed by Evolis SAS.

In accordance with applicable regulations, the participant may request to obtain and verify the data that Evolis SAS holds on him/her, rectify inaccurate information, delete data concerning him/her, and take a copy of his/her data for re-use elsewhere. He/she may also object at any time to the use of some of his/her data, in particular for commercial prospecting or profiling purposes, and ask to freeze the use of his/her data. Lastly, the participant may define instructions concerning the fate of his or her data in the event of death. In the absence of a reply or satisfactory response from Evolis SAS, the participant may lodge a complaint with the Commission Nationale Informatique et Libertés (CNIL).

Article 7: Game rules

The rules may be sent free of charge to any person who requests them from the Organizer.

The Organizer reserves the right to extend, shorten, modify or cancel the game at any time, particularly in the event of force majeure, without participants being able to claim any compensation.

Article 8: Industrial and intellectual property

The reproduction, representation or use of all or part of the elements making up the game, including these rules, is strictly prohibited.

All trademarks, logos, texts, images, videos and other distinctive signs reproduced on the site where the rules are available, as well as on sites to which the rules allow access via hypertext links, are the exclusive property of their owners and are protected as such by the provisions of the French Intellectual Property Code for the entire world. Their unauthorized reproduction constitutes an infringement punishable by law. Any total or partial unauthorized reproduction of these trademarks, logos and signs constitutes an infringement punishable by law. Any use of the elements of the game, by whatever means, is subject to compliance with the rules of intellectual property.

Article 9: Disputes & complaints

These rules are governed by French law.

In the event of a dispute or claim, for any reason whatsoever, requests must be sent to the Organizer within 2 (two) months of the end of the Contest (as evidenced by the postmark). After this date, no claims will be accepted.

Any dispute arising in connection with this Game that cannot be settled amicably shall be submitted to the competent court.
